TRUSCOTT MINING LISTS ON ASX
EXPLORATION UNDERWAY

After successfully closing its Initial Public Offer, gold-copper explorer Truscott Mining Corporation Ltd (ASX Code: TRM) is set to make its debut on the ASX today, Wednesday 18th April, 2007.

Based in Western Australia, and with exploration properties targeting high grade gold and base metals in Tennant Creek (NT) and near Nullagine (WA), Truscott raised a total of \$2.9 million, from the Offer of \$2.7 million and with oversubscriptions of \$0.2 million also accepted.

“Exploration at Eastern Creek, near Nullagine, is underway and our field team is already on site,” Truscott’s Executive Chairman Peter Smith said today. “We have also established a field office in Tennant Creek and look forward to drill testing of gold targets at our Ewan Edward property, as soon as access after the recent wet season can be established.”

Additional drill targets are anticipated to be generated from recent reprocessing of detailed airborne geophysical data over Ewan Edward, in conjunction with the previous detailed ground gravity dataset.

The Company is very pleased with the support it has already received, and welcomes all shareholders for what promises to be an exciting time ahead.
